Recently, parish councillors have been surveying our litter bins to see if we have the right number of bins in the right places. All the litter bins, whether on Parish Council land, such as the Recreation Ground, or on the street are owned by Ashwell Parish Council. North Herts Council (NHC) are the authority responsible for street cleansing and empty the on-street bins once every 4 weeks.

We are aware that some of our bins are in a poor state and either need removing or replacing.

NHC are also conducting a survey and you may see their purple stickers on the bins. Please respond to them on this.
