It was good to talk last night. A quick update:

- I ran into PCSOs Chris Brabrook and Hannah Moss this morning. They said there would be no problem with displaying signs alerting road users to the presence of litter-pickers (just as long as you don't obstruct the highway to the extent that road users can't pass). It would be a good idea to let them both know when a pick is about to take place, contact details in the Yearbook.
- The Parish Clerk has added an information item about litter-picking to the Agenda for the next Parish Council meeting (1-Oct), noting that a group will be at work sometime in the autumn and that this is not a Parish Council driven initiative. We will no doubt take the opportunity to thank you for stepping forward and your willingness to help the village.
