

New trees and hedges in the village

You may have seen the new planting done by various groups around the village including:



- In Dixies Close. Replacement trees along the grass verges including flowering cherries, Sorbus and Malus, to replace those lost over the years (planting by Herts County Council following a Greening Ashwell initiative).

- In Silver Street on the grass bank. Three new trees, two Field maples and a Sorbus, to replace the large Ash that was rotten and had to be removed (planting by Herts County Council following a local residents' initiative).



- At Small Gains next to the allotments. Two new trees, a Crab apple and a Rowan, in addition to those planted last year (planting by the Parish Council).

- At the Rec. Two new Lime trees and a section of native hedging. Another section of native hedging is planned (planting by the Parish Council as part of the Queen's Green Canopy celebrations for the Jubilee).
