Dear Ashwell Parish Council. Place Services (ECC) have been commissioned by North Herts District Council to undertake a Conservation Area Appraisal for Ashwell and I am contacting you in the very early stages of the project. Good morning Jane,  
At present we are still at an early stage of the project, undertaking the research and site visits. This will be followed by the compilation of a draft document. We will be submitting the first draft document to North Herts in February of 2022. So if any contributions could be received before the end of November, that would be most helpful. There will be a public consultation phase undertaken in the spring of next year, once North Herts are happy with the draft document.

Ideally, contributions should be concise and focussed on the special historic and architectural interest of areas or buildings, as it is these factors that define a conservation area. We may not have much time to read and digest large bodies of written work, so a succinct summary with perhaps images and references would be very helpful indeed.
