## Invitation for applications

**Are you from a family which has a low income or is in financial hardship?**

The Trustees of the Henry Colborn Trust are empowered to apply the Trust's income:-

- a) To provide special benefits, of a kind not normally provided by the Local Education Authority, for Ashwell Primary School; and
- b) In otherwise promoting the education, including social and physical training, of children resident in the parish of Ashwell.**

The Trustees wish to invite applications for grants to be considered under clause **(b)**, particularly from families on a low income or in financial hardship.

**'Children'** means 18 and still in full-time education, or under 18.

**'Resident in the parish of Ashwell'** means living in Ashwell full-time.

Examples of **'Social and physical training'** might be martial arts lessons, paying for sports or physical activities, paying your child's expected contribution towards weekend trips away with Scouts, Girl Guides, Sea Rangers – and many other examples besides.

**Applications should be made using the Trust's online application form. Applications by post and email will not be considered.**

**The deadline for applications is 30 April 2019, but please look at the website below for further information no later than 15 APRIL so that you have plenty of time to understand the application process and submit your application.**
