2.2 (119.2) **Ashwell and Morden Station (South Cambridgeshire)**/proposals by the local landowner (Mr Jeremy Fordham of Odsey Properties Ltd) for a car park, footways and housing development near the station; this to include an improved footway/cycleway with Ashwell.

MGH – Nothing further to report.

2.3 (119.3) Village hall/transfer to the Parish Council of the holding (or custodian) trusteeship.

MNW - Progress is now being made since the appointment of a new solicitor. Various documents have been received from them and are being reviewed.

2.6.2 (119.6.2) Climate Change – Ashwell Climate Conversations group. No further information received.
2.6.3 (119.6.3) Neighbourhood Watch/Village Facebook page. Parishioner Janice Willis has reported that the Crime Prevention Day to be organised by PCSO Chris Brabrook has been postponed.

2.6.4 Moss Cottage Homes charity. A response has been sent to the Chairman of the trustees, Madeleine Legg, endorsing the proposal that Ann Robertshaw re reappointed as a trustee.

2.6.5 The **Annual Parish Meeting** due to be held on Wednesday 25th March, has been cancelled.

2.6.6 Coronavirus/Covid-19 emergency. The Parish Council has joined with St Marys and the United Reformed Churches in promoting the 'Hello, if you are self-isolating I can help' system. 2.8 (119.10) Working Groups reports.

2.8.1 Neighbourhood Plan (leader Cllr Graham Lee, deputy Cllr Norton Mahy and parishioners)

GEL -With the assistance of a Planning Consultant who specialises in preparing Neighbourhood Plans, plus valuable input from members of the NP Group we have re-drafted the Neighbourhood Plan. On the advice of Clare Skeels of NHDC this is being sent to Historic England to assess whether a Strategic Environmental Assessment (SEA) is required prior to issuing for Regulation 14 Consultation. That Consultation period lasts for 6 weeks, so the next milestone is likely to be reached during June. The cost of the Consultant's input has been fully covered by a Grant from Groundwork UK.

2.8.2 Local business support. (leader Cllr Graham Lee) *See below re new village map.*

2.8.3 Trees. (leader Cllr David Sims) *See item 2.6.1above re planting at the old Cooke's site and below re Small Gains.*

2.8.4 Village Sports Day (parishioners) Cancelled due to the coronavirus/Covid-19 emergency.

2.8.5 Litter Picking (leader Cllr Norton Mahy and parishioners) Postponed due to the coronavirus/Covid-19 emergency.

3. Matters of report from previous meetings.

New village map.

GEL- Work continues on the design of the new Map which is focussed on highlighting local retail businesses and visitor places of interest. It is hoped that the Map will be ready for printing to be available for local residents and village visitors by the time that freedom of movement returns to normal following the Covid 19 pandemic.

5.2 (122.6) Chestnut tree/development in front of Townsend House opposite the Recreation Ground.

The Chestnut tree has been felled. Following the independent report commissioned by NHDC they withdrew the temporary Tree Preservation Order (TPO). In addition to the Parish Council's objections there were many from parishioners/local residents.

5.3 (122.7) District Local Plan Examination.

The further hearings have been postponed due to the coronavirus/Covid-19 emergency.
